DRIVE –THRU ROUTE FOR DINNERS

Please enter the lot on the east side of the high school (the teacher's lot) off of Second Street. There, you will be directed around the All Saints building. You will be given your sides at the breezeway area and your dinners will be delivered to you at the south door by the ramp. **THERE WILL BE NO "SPECIAL REQUEST" ORDERS.** Please stay in your vehicle and be prepared with boxes, laundry baskets, etc. for us to load your dinners for safe transport. You will be directed to exit through First Street. **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING.** If someone is picking up a lot of dinners, they will be directed off to the side and the dinners will be delivered to their vehicle by volunteers. **No driver should get out of their vehicle.**

DINNER TICKETS

Dinner tickets will go on sale Monday, September 21. They can be purchased from any elementary school student (3rd through 6th Grade), any high school student (7th through 12th Grade) or at the Ministry Center. Students will not go door-to-door selling tickets. If you do not know a student, please come to the Ministry Center to purchase your tickets. **ALL TICKETS ARE PRESALE ONLY.** The prices for the tickets will be \$10.00 for adults and \$7.50 for children (5th grade and under). Persons purchasing tickets from students must give the money for the tickets, plus the desired pick up day of either Saturday or Sunday, to the student. The student will get the tickets from the school and then give the tickets to the buyer. **ALL DINNERS WILL BE DRIVE-THRU ONLY!**

There will be no "SPECIAL ORDER" requests. Drive-thru dinners will be available from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturday and from 3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday. Dinners will be served in a Styrofoam container. The dinner ticket campaign will end for the students and the Ministry Center on Tuesday, October 13. As a reminder, please bring your own boxes, laundry baskets, etc. with you to manage transporting your dinners safely. Please stay in your car and we will load your dinners for you.

FOOD DONATIONS

To make a food donation, please pull up to the south door (near the ramp) on First Street, and we will come out to your car. Cash donations for food, not dropped in the Sunday collection or given in advance may also be given to the ladies in charge. The hours will be Thursday, October 15th from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., Friday, October 16th from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Saturday, October 17th from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. We are in need of donations of milk, sticks of real butter and fresh parsley and large cast iron skillets (prior to the dinner). **NO CAKES** this year please, we will not be eating in the dining room.

HOME DELIVERIES OF DINNERS

We are now taking orders for home deliveries of the dinners. Please remember that this service is only for those who are shut-in and elderly people who are physically unable to drive or do not have someone to pick up their dinners. Meals will only be delivered Sunday, October 18 starting at 3:30 p.m. You may order meals by sending a check payable to Delphos St. John Church to Ken Kreeger, 1351 Carolyn Drive, Delphos, Ohio 45833 or call him at 567-765-1877. Prices are \$10.00 for an adult meal and \$7.50 for a child's meal; please specify chicken (white or dark meat) or beef. All dinners must be prepaid.
