## **Volunteer Requirements (for helping AT SCHOOL)**

The Toledo Diocese requires volunteers to be up to date with the Diocesan Protecting Our Youth program. Volunteers need to take the Protecting our Youth course every five years, and it is now all done through a program called Virtus. There are also a background check and a requirement to sign the Expectations Form, which are done through a link in the Virtus online program. The Virtus program uses the online Social Security background check and does not require fingerprints. There is a \$25 fee for the background check. Be sure to complete the online training course and the background check. Thank you, volunteers!

If you have previously completed background checks and/or a Protecting Our Youth course at any point before, you most likely already have an account in VIRTUS. If it has been more than 5 years, then you will want to contact Mary Pat Smith, Safe Environment Compliance Coordinator, at the Pastoral Center before you set up a new account.
